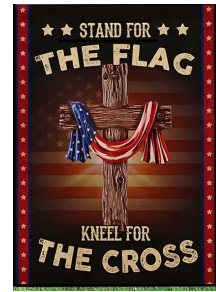

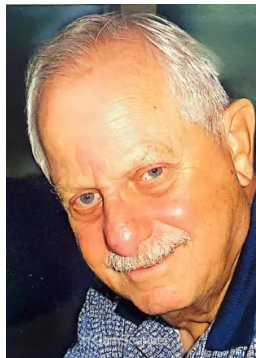

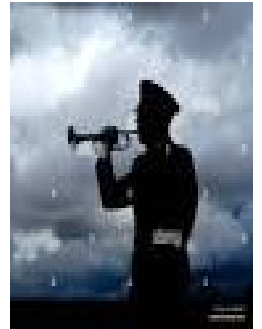
JOHN M. BUCCIGROSSI
